

Subject: 517th Address List update

We are currently working on updating the 517th address, which contains all known troopers, family and friends who we have addresses for. Not too long ago, we included postcards with the Thunderbolt asking people to confirm their addresses. We received confirmations from about 228 people, out of a list that had 1027 people a few years ago. We have also tried to keep track of Thunderbolts which have been returned as undeliverable, and when that happens, we remove them from the mailing list. In addition, we are going through other lists of people who made contributions to the 517th and asked to receive Thunderbolts. Part of the issue in the past is that these notes have been sent to various people including MailCall, the Treasurer, the Thunderbolt, officers, and who knows where else. So we are doing our best to catch up and pull them all together. As of today here are the counts:

As of today, we will send the next Thunderbolt to the 228 confirmed. But anyone who attended a recent reunion understands that we cannot afford to print and pay postage for the 787 "unknowns", most of whom probably have not contacted us in years. Much of the news in the Thunderbolt is copied from past MailCalls, but is delivered to the many troopers who do not have email access. So it is an important connection to older troopers. But there is also a substantial cost to having these printed and delivered. Note that we have to pay for postage, as well as returned postage for those that are not deliverable and also forwarding postage for people who have moved.

What is interesting (to me), it that the current list of MailCall readers (not to be confused with Thunderbolt readers) had held steady for the past few years at around 480 people. (I'm not sure how many of the 480 MailCall "readers" actually read the MailCalls, but since there's no cost to deliver it, it doesn't matter.)

On the next page is a list of the 228 "yes" people who are on the Thunderbolt list. If you are not on the list, but you do want to receive the printed Thunderbolt, please send me a note letting me know that, as well as your mailing address.
