## *July 9, 1944 – 71 Years Ago This Week*

## "IF WE COULD SPEAK".....

### COLONEL GRAVES

When the chaplain asked me to speak to you here this morning, it occurred to me that, since this service is devoted to the men we have lost in action, it would be fitting to express some of the things that, were they here, they would like to say to you.

If they could speak now, they would probably remind us to do certain things as members of their squad, their platoon or their company, their battalion or combat team. This is what I believe they would say to you:

- « Carry on the tradition of our outfit, the foundation of which we have laid with our lives. Stick with the job until it is finished, in order that you may return to the homes which we shall never see.
- « You have the power and the will to defeat any enemy you may face. However, profit by our mistakes that you may prevent unnecessary casualties to yourself and your comrades.
- Enjoy yourself when the opportunity is given, but take care of your health in every way, that our unit may go into the next fight with its full strength of men who have fought well and worked well together.
- If your next mission is an airborne one, we will jump with you in spirit. See, therefore, that it is a good jump and a strong blow against an enemy who has planned the enslavement of the free people of the world.
- We extend our congratulations with great pride to those who have won the privilege of wearing the Infantry Combat Badge and to those men who have won citations for acts of courage beyond the call of duty while in action.
  - « God speed and happy landings. »
