J-2, **Capt. David H. Armstrong**, D/517 PIR commander and **second Lt. Loren S. James** make a final briefing on the respective tasks of each squad for the big jump.

Dave Armstrong will be seriously injured on D-Day by landing on a pine tree, injuring the backyard. Loren James will be in command of D Company until war end.
