Hello, My Uncle, **Lt. Charles M. Willis** was part of Operation Dragoon. The purpose of this email is to find out whether he had recently joined the 460th and jumped into France with this unit. Can you please check your roster of the men who jumped into France?

Lt. Willis was originally an officer with 513-E PIR, from its inception until about March of 1945. He was sent to the Mediterranean area ahead of the 460th PFA, so if he was part of the 460th during Operation Varsity, he joined the 460th in the late spring or summer of 1944. (There were hints in his V-mail that he was with an artillery unit, and he also had begun pilot training, perhaps to become an artillery spotter).

Lt. Willis was wounded or was injured during the invasion and after a period of recuperation was assigned to the 12th Armored Division in December of 1944. He was assigned to the 56th Armored Infantry

Battalion, Co. A. He subsequently earned a Bronze Star (for valor) and a Silver Star and was KIA on March 23rd, 1945 in Speyer, Germany.
