Members of the community are invited to join the Director of the VAEKHCS, Mr. Rudy Klopfer along with Senator Jerry Moran, the 1<sup>st</sup> Infantry Division's Deputy Commander, Brigadier General Patrick Frank, and members of the Seitz Family for this grand opening of the new clinic named, in honor, after the late Lieutenant General Richard J. Seitz. Also in attendance will be the Director of the Veterans Integrated Service Network (15) Dr. William Patterson as well as various veteran service organizations, state, military, and local community leaders. The clinic, which broke ground, last June, is a (near) 10-thousand square foot medical facility offering increased staff and specialty care to provide a higher level of health care for our veterans close to home while improving the coordination of care and customer satisfaction for veterans and their family members within this geographic region. The new VA Clinic is located at 1169 Southwind Drive just south of Ash Street at Highway 77.



We welcome all types of visitors to our cemeteries, but we're especially privileged when a WWII veteran travels across the ocean to visit our hallowed grounds. WWII Veteran Charles Davis, who served in the 517th Parachute Infantry Regiment, 17th Airborne Division, paid a visit to Luxembourg American Cemetery last week. Traveling with the Scions of the 17th Airborne, a group open to veterans, family members, and descendants of the division, they laid flowers at the grave site of each soldier from the 17th buried there, and laid a wreath in the memorial chapel. During the visit, the cemetery conducted a flag exchange with Davis so that he would have one that flew over the cemetery. #ww2 #wwii #ww2veteran #wwiiveteran

The 517 Signal Company was with the 17th in the battle of the bulge, as was the 507th PIR and the 513th PIR which replaced the 517th PIR.
