


Hello Bob,

I am still doing research on Gen. John H. Neiler, mostly now to be able to give more information to his wife about where he went while in Italy, France, Belgium, and Germany. Gen. Neiler never shared any photos of himself from the war, so Mrs. Neiler was very happy to see the photos that you directed me to. Those photos are from Howard Hensleigh's collection, submitted by Jean-Loup Gassend. I recently found another photo on the website that shows members of Hq with the description of "somewhere in France, 1944" and thought that the building was distinctive enough that I may be able to pin-point its location. I listed all of the French towns where the 517th stopped for extended periods (apparent based on dress individuals in the photo). The only two places that looked promising were in Soissons and Peira Cava. Using Google Maps and StreetView, I searched in Soissons for the building. Nothing. So then I searched in Peira Cava and quickly noticed that the architecture was way off. But then I noticed something familiar. Next to the two pictures of the then Lt. Neiler is a photo of Russ Johnson sitting on the hood of a Jeep. While looking at StreetView in Peira Cava, I noticed the same building profile. After comparing both photos, I identified several features that were common to both. After a few discussions with Mr. Gassend and further comparison to other photos of the building. I believe that the location that these three photos has been identified. The building behind Mr. Neiler and to the left of Mr. Johnson was the Grand Hotel Faraut. Please see the attached comparison.

Now, getting back to the group photo, I have asked other military enthusiasts if they recognized the building to no avail. I was about to give up when I stumbled on another discovery. While doing a google search (I can't even remember now what it was), I saw another photo of Lt. Neiler and other photos from a page in the 13th Airborne History book, which is also on the 517th website. I had never seen the other photos, so I was a little excited. I had never looked at the 13th Airborne Book as a source as I figured that the association was too brief. That was a mistake. Anyway, I scrolled through the remainder of the pages and got to the last one, when lo and behold, I see the same building, shot from a different angle, with the caption "Joigny, France". This appears to the be the "small hotel" (as described in the Paratroopers' Odyssey book) where Hq used as their headquarters after Ardennes and before heading home. I still have not located the building on Google Maps or StreetView, but I am still looking.






- 1 Port Windows

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Same shutters


same window proportions
