

I am trying to contact family members of the following Troopers of the 517

Major Donald W. Fraser Lt. Ralph W. Emmons PFC Robert Steele Private James Marshall

The reason I am trying to contact any surviving family members of these men is that they were all were present on the day my Uncle was killed. Lt. Emmons was in the jeep and wounded in that same attack. I am assuming most of these men are now deceased due to the passage of time, however if by chance any of them are still alive and able to respond I would love to hear back from you.

Major Fraser, who was a Captain at the time, PFC Steele, and PVT Marshall were in the jeep behind them. They went forward and attempted to rescue the wounded. My uncle was KIA in a mortar barrage that day as witnessed by Captain Fraser. All three of these gentlemen earned the Silver Star that day for their actions.

LT. Emmons had to go back a few weeks later to identify my uncle's remains as his dog tags were missing.

I would like to thank you for what your relative tried to do for my Uncle and the other men in that jeep that day. It is greatly appreciated.

I have been able to contact the son of another Trooper that was present that day. His father was Hoyt Kelley. I found some email address's for Major Fraser's relatives on the Roster, but these may be wrong as I have never heard back from any of those contacts.

Unfortunately, I do not have contact info for any of these four. I don't see that any of them have been on our old mailing roster since at least 2008. **Fraser, Steele** and **Marshall** were all with HQ Company 1st Battalion, and **Lt. Emmons** with B Company in the December 1944 roster.

I do see one note looking unsuccessfully for **Bob Steele**, back in <u>MailCall 951</u> in 2005:

Hi Ben. There was a Bob Steel in "A" Company from our origin until he was commissioned in South France and moved to headquarters. Have been trying to contact him for years. He was from the southern California area and I did hear that he was in South America as a mining engineer. A smart guy. Seems he had a brother named Stirling who lived in this area but that was some years ago. Do not know any more than that


